How to Create a Donation Drive

- 1 Reach out to our Donations Coordinator** to let us know you are hosting a drive. We can help you choose items that will make the most impact on the families we work with.
- 2 Pick a theme** to make the donation drive memorable. For example, an underwear and sock drive, toiletries drive, baby items drive, cleaning supplies, laundry supplies, or food pantry items. Fun names are always a plus.
- 3 Set a start and end date.** Let our staff know so we can be expecting a large donation.
- 4 Provide a clear list** of the items you are collecting. Use posters, flyers, emails, and social media to tell the group what to donate. Contact us and we can send you our logos! Encourage people to visit our website to learn about what we do at www.dorothydaymemphis.org.
- 5 Provide clearly marked boxes** or tubs in centralized and visible locations if you are doing an in-person donation drive.
- 6 Designate group members to deliver the donations** to the Dorothy Day House. Donations can be delivered to our warehouse space 9am to 4pm, Monday – Friday. Please contact us to set up a drop-off time.
